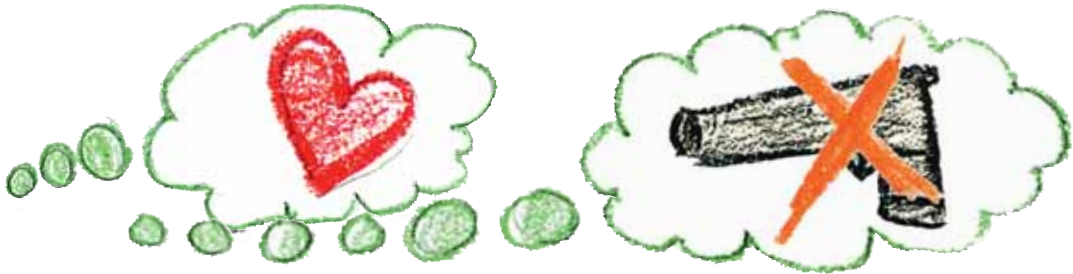

Kids

If you see a gun:

- Don't touch it.
- Move away from it.
- Get help from an adult.

Parents

If you keep a gun:

- Always keep it unloaded and locked up with a gun lock.
- Lock and store bullets separately.

Even if you don't own a gun:

Talk to your children about guns.

Ask parents of your children's friends if they have guns at home and how they're stored.



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
